## Definition:

- Tells how two things are similar and different
- **Compare** = find similarities
- **Contrast** = find differences

## Signal Words

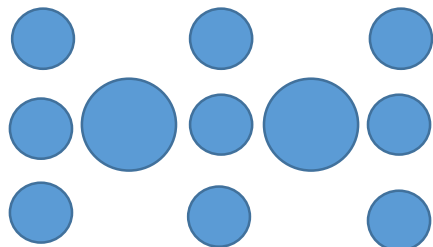
