- How the text is organized
- All stories are chronological
- Nonfiction has lots of text structures
- The text structure of each paragraph may be different from the next.
- Helps you to understand the text better

Descriptive / Spatial

Definition:

- Focuses on or explains one things (a topic, idea, person, please) and its parts by listing characteristics, features, and examples
- Spatial organization is when information is explained in order of space or location


